

# Village of Luxemburg Yard Waste Pick-Up

The intent of the yard waste pickup is to provide residents the disposal of brush and yard waste generated as a result of routine yard maintenance.

Yard waste pick-up schedule is as follows:

**Every Monday between the following dates**

**Starts: Third Monday in April**  
**Ends: Monday after Thanksgiving (weather permitting)**

Starting on the third Monday in April all yard waste can be placed in piles on the curb until the second Monday in May.

From the third Monday in May to the second Monday in October all yard waste must be placed in open containers at the curb (except brush).

After the second Monday in October, all yard waste can be placed in piles back on the curb until the end of the season.

Please do not put yard waste on tarps. (If you can't lift it, neither can we)

## Grass cutting

Please do not blow grass clippings onto the street or in the curb.

Excessive amounts of grass clippings left on the street or curb will be picked up by the public works department at the owner's expense

## Brush Collection Information

- Brush up to 3" in diameter is acceptable in lengths no greater than 12 feet.
- Brush up to 6" in diameter is acceptable in lengths no greater than 8 feet.
- Brush greater than 6" in diameter cannot be accepted at the curb. Larger brush including stump disposal, is the responsibility of the homeowner.
- Avoid cutting brush shorter than needed, as fewer pieces make less handling for Public Works employees.
- Lay brush in piles at the curb with the butt ends facing the street. All branches should be laying in the same direction.
- Please do not put brush at the curb any sooner than one week prior to the collection day.
- Brush must be at the curb prior to the Monday that brush is scheduled to be picked up. Brush not at the curb by the time Public Works employees come past, will be left until the next pick-up. If you request immediate pickup you will be

billed for the labor/equipment charges of the Public Works employees to come back.

- Clearing of brush on lots for the intent to build or sell the lot will not be picked up. The intent of the pickup is to provide for disposal of brush generated as a result of routine yard maintenance. If excessive amounts of brush are placed at the curb, the brush may be refused or a fee will be charged for the work. Entire trees cut down are the homeowner's responsibility to remove and cleanup.

Christmas tree removal will begin on the Monday after the Christmas Holiday and will go until the end of January. This pickup will be on a weekly basis.

### **Village of Luxemburg Drop-off Site Information**

- The Village drop-off site is located at 118 Prairie Ln.
- The drop-off site is intended for Village residents ONLY.
- Do NOT drop-off garbage, brick, stones, large stumps, gravel etc.
- Any yard waste in plastic bags has to be removed from the bag and it is the resident's responsibility to dispose of the bags.
- If bringing large amounts of brush/branches/bushes etc., please contact Village Hall to make arrangements for drop off. (920-845-2722).
